Stained Glass In Our Church

We have beautiful stained glass windows in the Church of the Immaculate Conception. Some of these stained glass windows show pictures and symbols of our faith and others are more abstract.

Stained glass windows were traditionally used to show stories of faith. They were installed at a time when many people were unable to read and the pictures on the windows were a reminder of faith stories and lessons.

Often richer people in a parish donated money for a window in the church. If you look closely, you might be able to see that the beautiful five panel stained glass window behind the altar in the Church of the Immaculate Conception is inscribed *'Presented by P McMenamin, J.P., the generous donor'*
